Birmingham Cit Council is required to carr out a Communit Governance Revie . This revie included nding out hat local people, like ou, think about the idea. The Balsall Heath Communit Governance Revie took place bet een Februar and Jul 2022.

All the communit feedback as revie ed. It sho ed most people ho responded supported the idea of a Balsall Heath Neighbourhood Council and anted to e plore the proposal further.

The Cit Council Cabinet decided the proposal should go to the ne t stage – a 'consultative ballot' of Balsall Heath residents. This means that ever Balsall Heath resident ho is eligible to vote ill be able to have their sa on hether a neighbourhood council is created in Balsall Heath.

The Cit Council Cabinet and the full Cit Council ill decide on hether a neighbourhood council is created, based on the result of the ballot and the proportion of people ho vote.

So it's important to make sure ou return our ballot paper and have our sa .

A postal consultative ballot was held in November - December 2022.

WHY IS THERE A RE-BALLOT?

In the consultative ballot held in Nov – Dec 2022, the turnout of eligible voters as 22% ith 78% voting Yes. Birmingham Cit Council required a turnout of at least 25% of eligible voters and the decided a re-ballot should be held.

The re-ballot is being held from 5th June -3rd July. This is a postal ballot.

Please note: all those who voted in the first ballot will need to vote again in this ballot.

All Balsall Heath residents ho are registered to vote in Cit Council elections ill be sent a postal ballot paper by the Independent Scrutineer, Civica Election Services at the end of Ma read for voting during June.

To be counted, the ballot paper must be received b Civica no later than 5pm on Monda 3rd Jul .

Please post your vote in good time so it arrives by 3rd July.
