What are the signs of measles?

Measles is a highly infectious condition that can cause serious illness and in rare cases be fatal; the first signs of measles are:

High temperature;

Runny or blocked nose;

Sneezing;

Cough;

Red, sore, watery eyes;

A rash will usually appear a few days after cold-like symptoms (sometimes starts around the ears before spreading to the rest of the body).

Measles can cause complications, especially in certain at-

This is especially important when measles is circulating because any child or adult who has not had at least one dose of MMR and comes into contact with a person with measles will have to be excluded from nursery, school or work for 21 days.
