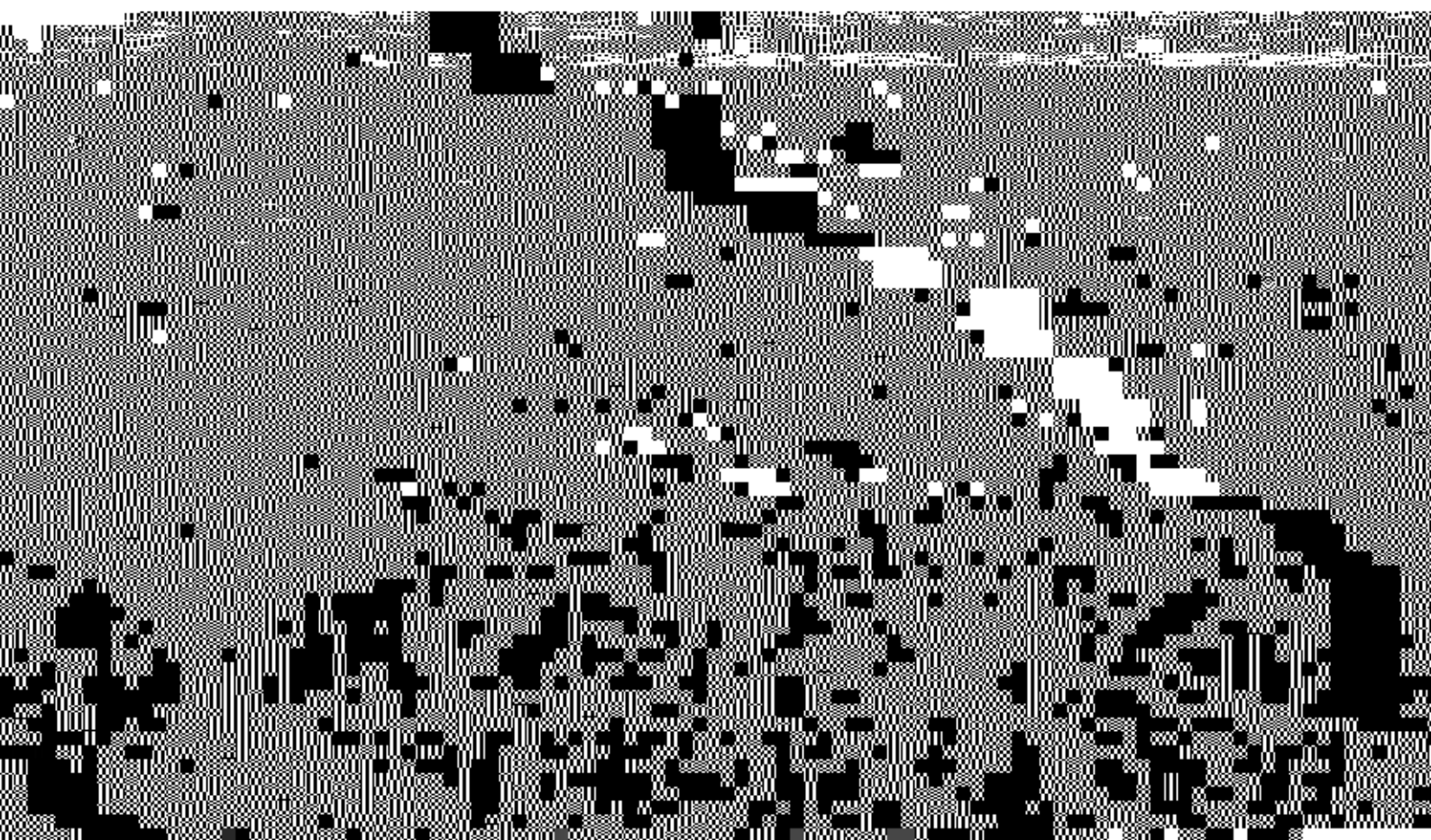

Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP 223

- 1 The path is first recorded on the map with the Northfield Tithe Apportionment of 1840. (Copy held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library.)
- 2 It is also shown, and labelled 'FP', on the first edition of the Ordnance Survey six inch map (1880's).
- 3 It is again shown, and labelled, on a Quarter Sessions Highways Order of 1929. (Held by the Central Reference Library, Archives section, under reference OS/B/21/1 (Box 14. Item 3. Form 151),)
- 4 The section east from St Helens Road, crossing Lockwood Road, was closed by diversion onto new streets, with a footpath link east from [redacted] [redacted] of the path, by a Quarter Sessions Highways Order made on the 14th August 1954 (Ref. OS/B/21/2 (Box 15. Item 500))
- 5 The east end of the path (south east from Ulvine Drive, now the line of the Northfield Relief Road) was closed and replaced with Path Claim BAP 224 by a single path by a Quarter Sessions Highways Order of 1957, the Certificate of Completion being dated 1958. (Ref. OS/B/21/2 (Box 15. Item 500))
- 6 This remaining section of path is shown on the Ordnance Survey Pathfinder map (sheet 954 of 1981).
- 7 This path is shown on the (undated) City Council map of [redacted]
