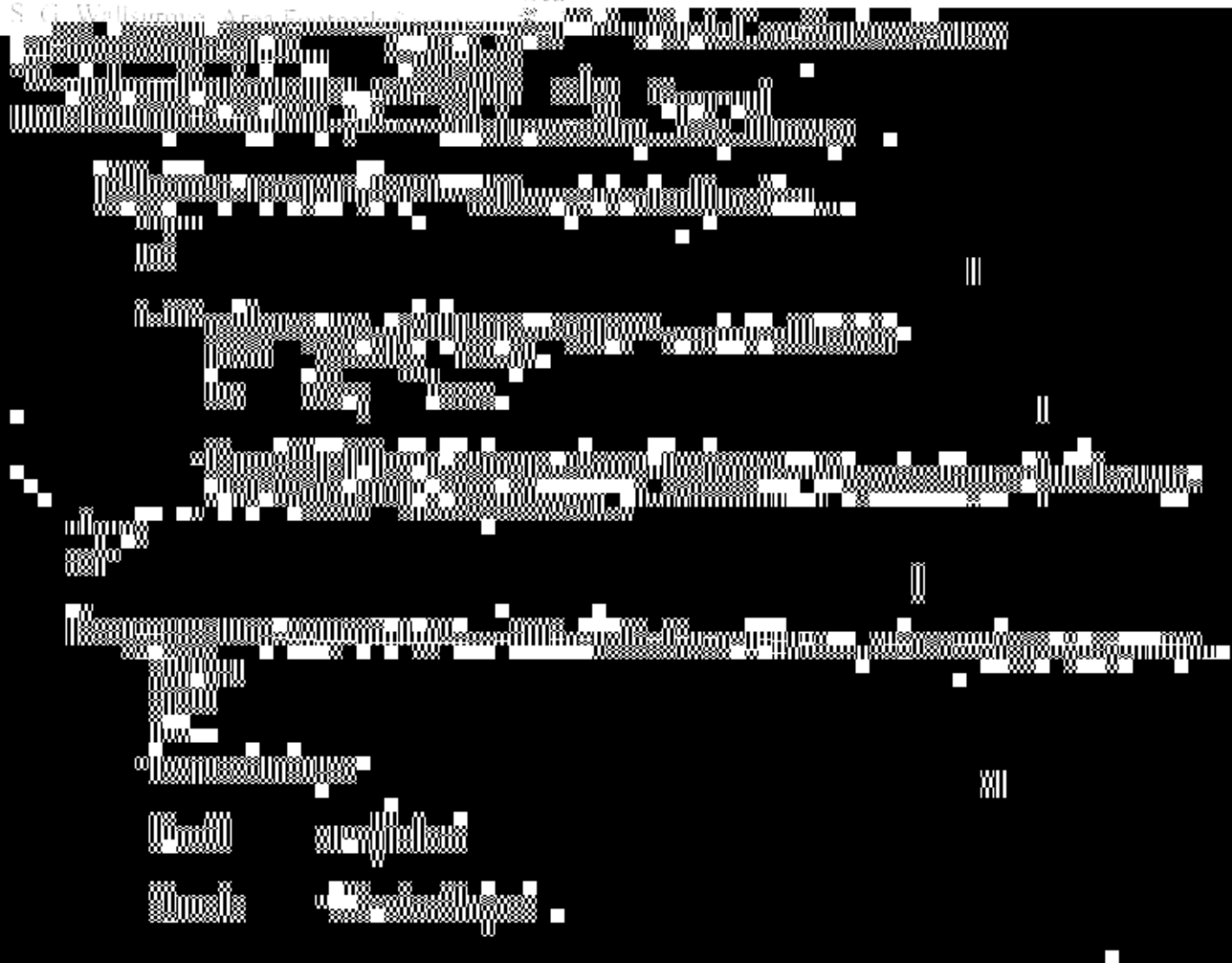

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Statement of Evidence for Path Claim BAP, 2024

1 The path is first shown on the map with the Yardley Tithe Apportionment of 1847. (Copy held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library.) The west end, however, is shown on a different alignment.

2 The route is shown on the first edition (1880's) of the Ordnance Survey 6 inch map.

3 The east end of the path was the subject of a Quarter Sessions Highways Order, which has a Certificate of Completion dated 24 September 1921, but no plan. (The Order is held by the City Council in the Central Reference Library.)

4 QS/B/21/1 (Box 14, Bundle 1, item 4.)

5 The east end of the route has subsequently been affected by development, as shown on recent and current 1/10,000 and 1/25,000 Ordnance Survey sheets, although no Diversion Order has been found.

6 The path is shown on the (undated) City Council map of public rights of way.

7 It is considered, therefore, that it is reasonable to allege that the route subsists as a public footpath and should be recorded as such on the Definitive Map.
